This is the sad news that three of our key CYP Services; '**Back on Track 11 to 17**' '**Connect with Respect**' and the '**Parent Hub**' will be ending in the next quarter. However, we will still be able to offer **CYP Outreach for 4 to 17 year olds** (from April to July 2016) and **Back on Track 7 to 11**. A recent **South Gloucestershire Health and Wellbeing online pupil survey** estimated that in an average class of 30, 5 students will have at some point encountered domestic abuse. National statistics also reveal that **750, 000** children a year will experience this in the family home.

NOW is the time therefore to act and put **PREVENTATIVE PROVISION** in place in your setting so that the **cycle of violence** is not passed down from generation to generation.

We are already working in South Gloucestershire Schools on a commissioned basis and have the support and recommendation of colleagues:

Due to their frequency we are able to refer children when and if required therefore being able to help change outcomes and quickly address issues before they develop further. Often we see children's behaviour at school and home change due to having the vocabulary and role modelling available to discuss issues relating to Domestic Abuse."
